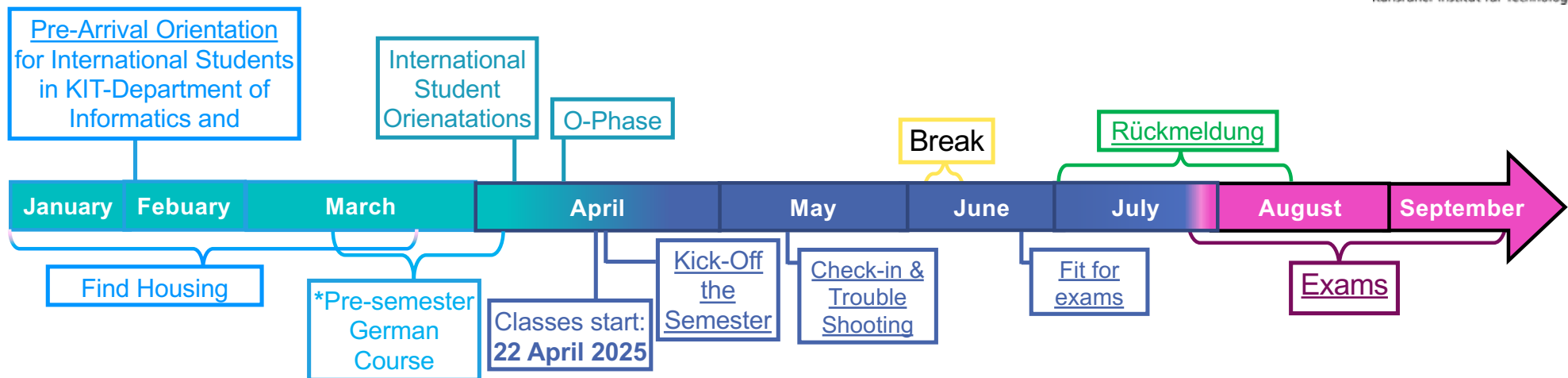

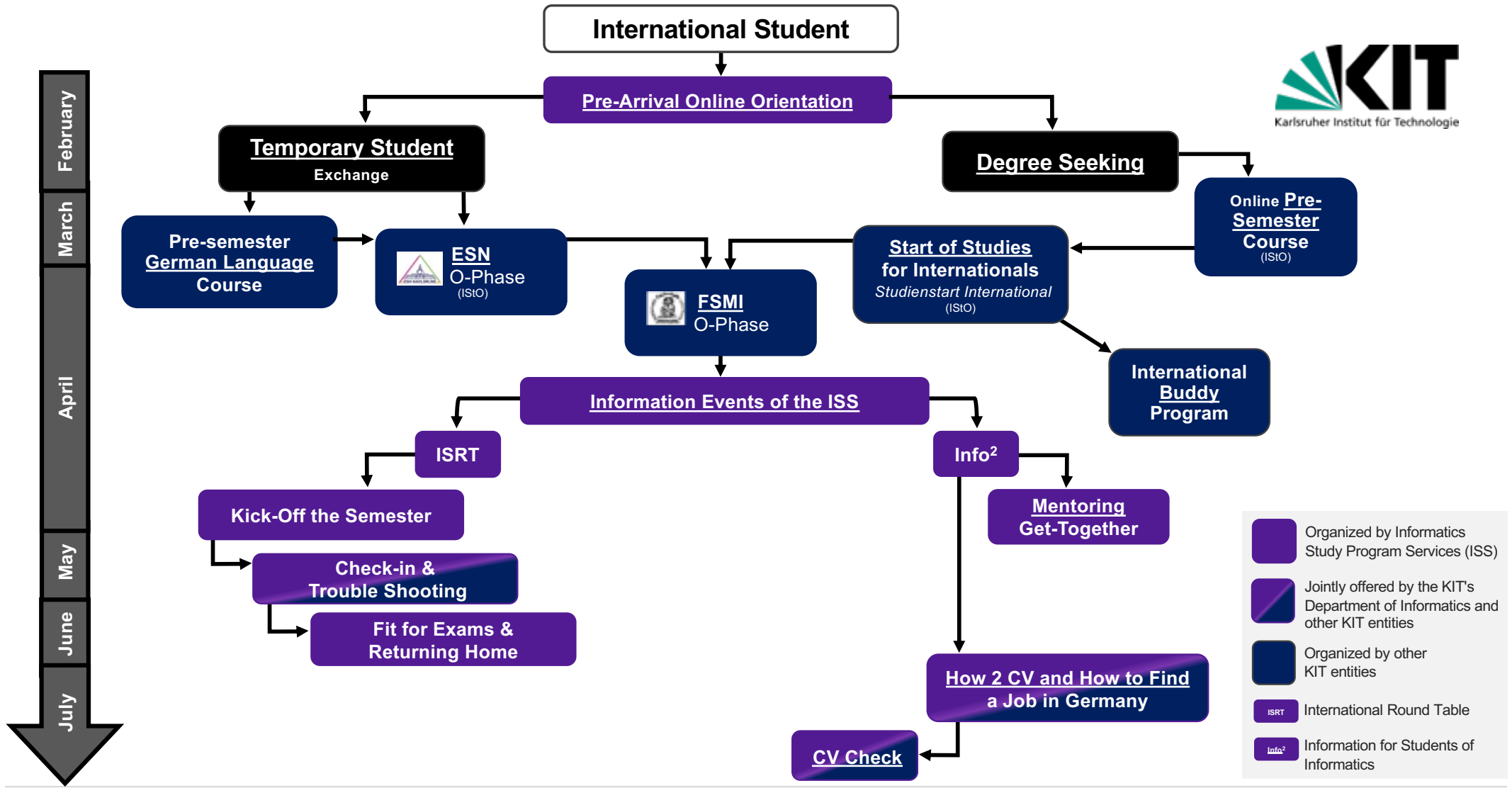

## Accommodations

### ■ Residence Halls (“Wohnheime”)

- Mostly operated by a public student service called “Studierendenwerk”. The International Office has a contingent of rooms in these dormitories that are reserved for students coming from overseas and Nordic countries.
- Also self-organised e.g. HaDiKo

### ■ Shared Flats (“Wohngemeinschaften”, often shortened WG).

- In many cases it is possible to Sublease a room for a limited time from students who temporarily left the town for an internship or to go abroad (Zwischenmiete\*). One of the many platforms to find shared flats is [wg-gesucht.de](https://www.wg-gesucht.de).
- “Zwischenmiete” is a German term used for the sub-renting an apartment, usually for a period of 5-6 months.

- Work on a particular topic, write about it and prepare and present it to the group
- Watch others presentations
- **Must register before courses begin** (depending on the seminar: ILIAS/ Website/ Email/ Wiwi-Portal ...)

## Lab

(Praktikum)

- Acquire more practical skills
- **Must register before courses begin** (depending on the lab: ILIAS/ Website/ Email/ Wiwi-Portal ...)

## Thesis

Bachelor- / Master
