



#### **Accomodations**

- Residence Halls ("Wohnheime")
  - Mostly operated by a public student service called "Studierendenwerk". The International Office has a contingent of rooms in these dormitories that are reserved for students coming from overseas and Nordic countries.
  - Also self-organised e.g. HaDiKo
- Shared Flats ("Wohngemeinschaften", often shortened WG).
  - In many cases it is possible to Sublease a room for a limited time from students who temporarily left the town for an internship or to go abroad (Zwischenmiete\*). One of the many platforms to find shared flats is wg-gesucht.de.
  - "Zwischenmiete" is a German term used for the sub-renting an apartment, usually for a period of 5-6 months.

#### □ Participate in Orientation


- Each of orientation focus a different content that is relevant to studying at KIT and living in Germany

- Another important reason to attend is that you can start build a social network and find study partners





#### Lecture

(Vorlesung)

- Sometimes with Übung & Tutorial
- Registration later in Semester (\*only need to register for the exam, most of the time not for attending)
- Please note that some lectures also include exercises, which must be successfully completed in order to complete the overall module.

#### **Seminar**

- Work on a particular topic, write about it and prepare and present it to the group
- Watch others presentations
- Must register before courses begin (depending on the seminar: ILIAS/ Website/ Email/ Wiwi-Portal ...)

#### Lab

(Praktikum)

- Acquire more practical skills
- Must register before courses begin (depending on the lab: ILIAS/ Website/ Email/ Wiwi-Portal ...)

#### **Thesis**

Bachelor- / Master

- Find advisor and topic (Visit the various Institute homepages to assist you in this process and e-mail potential advisors)
- Advisor will help to register the thesis
- Write and defend thesis



- The module handbook is the official guide for students regarding their academic progress and program of study
- It describes the modules and the corrsponding exams
- Each semester the Module Handbook (Modulhandbuch) is updated and rereleased with every module available
- The new handbook is available about a month before the semester begins
- Modules may be changed, deleted, replaced, expanded, or otherwise modified at any time
- Although every effort is made to ensure that students are admitted to their preferred course selections, the KIT Faculty for Informatics cannot guarantee admission to any particular course





- VVZ (Vorlesungsverzeichnis) Course Catalogue

- Be sure to select the right semester







#### **Learning Agreements (LA)**


- The LA is a contract between you, your home university and host university regarding your studies. It is important to comply with your LA.
- Please upload your LA on Mobility Online
- Please ensure that you enroll at least 70-80% Informatic Modules/course(s)
- Please ensure that you enroll and complete at least the minimum of required ECTS required by your home university.
- Changes to the LA "during the mobility" :Please be plan sufficient turn around time for you LA to be processed and signed (it may take up to 14 days)
